Benha University is qualified to participate at ACM Arab Collegiate programming contest May 2017

Two team at the faculty of engineering in Shubra have participated with 111 teams from different Arab universities in ACM Arab Collegiate programming contest May 2017.

This contest was held in Sharm-EL- Shiekh on Sunday, 13-11-2016 and one of the Benha university teams has qualified to participate in the international final (41) which will be held in May 2017 at “rapid city” in U.S.A.



This contest will also be held in the presence of 128 teams of the top universities around the world. The contest dates back to 1970 where the first local programming competition took place in Texas, U.S.A.

In 1989, the contest mainly includes many teams from the United States, but it includes, later on, different teams around the world. In 2005, the international contest includes teams from 84 countries around the world and this contest is a great opportunity for the big companies to find and adopt creative minds.
