# SOUTH AFRICA - EGYPT JOINT SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY RESEARCH PROGRAMME

# Call for Research Proposals – 2012/13

The Republic of South Africa and the Arab Republic of Egypt signed an Agreement for cooperation in science and technology on 26 August 1997. As part of enhancing scientific and technological cooperation, the two countries have decided to jointly support researchers from public universities and public research institutes on an equal and mutually beneficial basis.

In this call, the joint research project proposals shall be submitted to the relevant authorities in both countries for evaluation (the Ministry of Scientific Research in Egypt and the National Research Foundation in South Africa). Evaluation will be done according to the following criteria:

- Scientific and technical merit:
- Impact on bilateral science and technology relations;
- Significance for both countries;
- Potential for creating research:
- Quality and clarity of project presentation;
- · Methodology; suitability and feasibility and
- Capacity development

For the purposes of this call, research projects falling within the following thematic areas/disciplines will be considered:

- Nanotechnology
- Remote sensing and space science
- ICT
- Biotechnology (food production, agriculture and health)
- Laser technology
- Energy

Successful projects in South Africa will be funded up to a maximum amount of R300,000 over two years. Successful projects in Egypt will receive the equivalent amount in Egyptian national currency. **Researchers should therefore note that two separate budgets would be required from each side.** Researchers from the sending country will be responsible for their own international travel and the hosting costs (local travel, subsistence, accommodation and ground travel).

Funding may only be utilised for the following items:

- Flight tickets;
- Accommodation;
- Subsistence;
- Consumables and
- Publication costs;

The joint application for funding must include two Principal Investigators. The South African and the Egyptian applicants must be employed at a recognised research institution or higher education such as a university, university of technology or science council in their respective countries. The Principal Investigators from both countries must be in possession of a PhD and will be responsible for the scientific and financial reporting, as well as other technical and progress co-ordination of the project. They will also be required to submit annual and final reports to their respective funding agencies upon completion of the project. Researchers employed at private companies will not be allowed to apply under this programme.

#### The Egyptian application:

Application forms for proposal submission may be obtained from the Ministry of Scientific Research in Egypt (<a href="www.rdi.eg.net">www.rdi.eg.net</a>). The original and two copies of the project proposal plus one CD should include Curriculum Vitaes of the Principal Investigators and must be received by 31 August 2012 by hand or post as well as via e-mail. Signatures may either be signed electronically or scanned.

The Egyptian application, together with the scanned signature page must be emailed directly to <a href="mailto:sci\_info@msr.sci.eg">sci\_info@msr.sci.eg</a>.

### The South African application:

Application forms for proposal submission for the SA applicants may be obtained from the National Research Foundation (<a href="www.nrf.ac.za">www.nrf.ac.za</a>). Submissions should include Curriculum Vitaes of the Principal Investigators and must be received by 31 August 2012 via e-mail. Signatures may either be signed electronically or scanned. Please ensure that the partner's signed page is attached which may be a faxed or a scanned copy.

The SA application, together with the scanned signature page must be emailed directly to <a href="mailto:puleng.tshitlho@nrf.ac.za">puleng.tshitlho@nrf.ac.za</a>.

No South African applications will be accepted in Egypt.

No Egyptian applications will be accepted in SA.

No hard copies will be accepted and will be automatically disqualified by the NRF.

Only applications endorsed by the research office or its equivalent at higher education or research institutions will be accepted.

Kindly note that budget availability and proposals with a high evaluation rating are extremely important factors in determining the success of an application

The onus is on the applicant to find their own research partner. Researchers must ensure that applications have been submitted in both countries. Applications that do not adhere to this criterion will be disqualified. The NRF and the Ministry of Scientific Research will not be held responsible for non-submission of applications in the relevant country. It is for this reason that the applicant must insist on an acknowledgement receipt
